COMPLETION OF PLACEMENT EXPIRY AND ISSUE OF OPTIONS

On 22 March 2019 Key Petroleum Ltd (Key or Company) announced that it had completed arrangements for a capital raising via a placement of 142,103,766 ordinary fully paid shares at \$0.005 each to raise A\$710,518 (**Placement**) before costs.

The Company is now pleased to advise that it has completed the Placement.

Funds raised under the Placement will be expended by Key on the following:-

- Work to be conducted on, or in connection with, (a) the Tanbar Gas Project in the Cooper Basin within ATP924; (b) the Mount Horner Oilfield within L7; and (c) the drilling of either the Parce or Wye Knot prospects in EP 437 in the Perth Basin; and
- Additional working capital.

Expiry and Issue of Options

Key advises that 1,000,000 unlisted options having an expiry date of 9 March 2019 with an exercise price of 1.287 cents each have expired in accordance with the terms of the Company's Employee Share Option Plan.

Key also advises that the Company has issued 1,000,000 unlisted options having an expiry date of 27 March 2023 with an exercise price of 1.3 cents each in accordance with the terms of the Company's Employee Share Option Plan which was approved by shareholders at the annual general meeting held on 24 November 2017.

Key issued the Placement shares to institutional and sophisticated investors and they are part of a class of securities quoted on the Australian Securities Exchange Limited (ASX).

The Company gives this notice pursuant to Section 708A(5)(e) of the Corporations Act. The shares were issued without disclosure to the investors under Part 6D.2, in reliance on Section 708A(5) of the Corporations Act. The Company, as at the date of this notice, has complied with:
